



Prof. Kailash P. Bhatia, MD, DM, FRCP

- Professor Bhatia is Professor of Clinical Neurology in the Department of Clinical and Movement Neuroscience at UCL, Queen Square, London.
- He did his initial medical training in India followed by fellowships in neuro-genetics and movement disorders with the late Profs Anita Harding and David Marsden in London.
- His main focus is in dystonia and a range of movement disorders, merging clinical, genetic and electrophysiological methods to describe clinical phenotypes and pathophysiology.
- Professor Bhatia has over 820 peer reviewed publications and several books.
- He has been privileged to receive the Honorary membership of the MDS in 2021 and honoured to do the Stanley Fahn Oration in 2022 at the MDS congress in Madrid.
- He has been nominated the chairman- elect of the MDS-ES and is co-chief editor of the Movement Disorders Clinical Practise (MDCP) journal.
- Recently, he has been appointed President of the European Academy of Neurology.
