- Dr Rob Spull is a paediatric neurology doctor from the UK who undertook his medical training at the University of Oxford and Imperial College London before moving to Bristol for subspecialty training in paediatric neurology.
- Having developed an interest in neurogenetics and movement disorders, since 2020 he has been undertaking doctoral research training under the supervision of Professor Manju Kurian at University College London and Great Ormond Street Hospital.
- During his PhD on advancing precision therapies for paediatric neurogenetic conditions, Dr Spull has undertaken projects on several conditions such as CLN2-Batten disease and AADC deficiency, but with a primary focus on PKAN. This work has focussed on using clinical scales to monitor progression, assessment of novel disease markers such as detailed ophthalmological testing, and validating these as clinical trial outcome measures.
